Dear Ms Qiu:

Congratulations! I am happy to inform you that you have been admitted to the 2015 Summer Institute in Law and Economics at the University of Chicago Law School. We received applications from many excellent scholars, many of whom we had to turn down due to space constraints. We regarded your qualifications as exceptional for our program.

The Summer Institute's registration fee is \$2500, and must be paid prior to participation. We have very limited tuition assistance resources, since the tuition is already highly subsidized by the University of Chicago. But, if there is hardship or a special circumstance, please contact Joey Burton (jbarton@uchicago.edu), who can assist you in applying for a tuition reduction.

The Summer Institute will take place from Monday, July 6, 2015 through Friday, July 17, 2015. The academic program includes five separate lecture sequences on "Economic Analysis of Contracts and Commercial Law," delivered by Chicago's world-known experts. Each lecture sequence will involve five individual lectures on advanced topics in law-and-economics. The academic program also includes meetings with other legendary scholars from the University of Chicago.

The Summer Institute will also feature panels and colloquia in which you, as well as other participants, will be invited to present your own work. A Call-for-Papers for these panels will be sent to you upon receiving your completed Enrollment Agreement and deposit payment.

The lodging package that we are providing (and is covered as part of the registration fee) includes the following:

- 14 nights of housing, from July 4 through July 17 (to check out on Saturday, July 18), on the University of Chicago Campus in the South Campus dorm (single person occupancy). This new facility is conveniently located next to the Law School, where the lectures will take place.

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- Breakfast and lunch on weekdays
- Several official dinner events
- Various fun and entertainment outings in Chicago.

Not included in the hosting plan are dinners on the remaining nights and meals on weekends (there are many affordable restaurant options near campus). The weekend between the two weeks of lectures will be mostly free to allow you to explore Chicago

Please note that the University housing rules do not allow anyone other than the program scholars to stay.

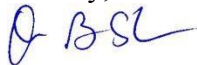
Finally, in order save you the slot in the 2015 Summer Institute, we ask two things. First, we ask that you sign and return to us the attached Enrollment Agreement, in which you confirm your commitment to participate in the Summer Institute. Second, we ask that you pay a \$500 nonrefundable deposit. You may make the deposit payment by credit card or by check. Please see the attached sheet for instructions on how to make the deposit.

Please send the Enrollment Agreement and the deposit to us no later than Monday February 13. Our Office of International Affairs has determined that you may travel to the U.S. with a B-1 visa to attend the Summer Institute. Please make an appointment with the U.S. consulate and bring this letter and your passport to the appointment.
